




Enrollment Trend Fall Oct. 1 Enrollment - *Excludes Early Childhood*













Ethnicity Trend Percent of Non-White Students
































Percent of Students Receiving Free/Reduced Lunch




23-24 Primary Languages








2023-2024 Home Language Breakdown Counts of 46* Known Primary Home Languages






Ethnicity and EL Trend Percent of Students Receiving EL Services
