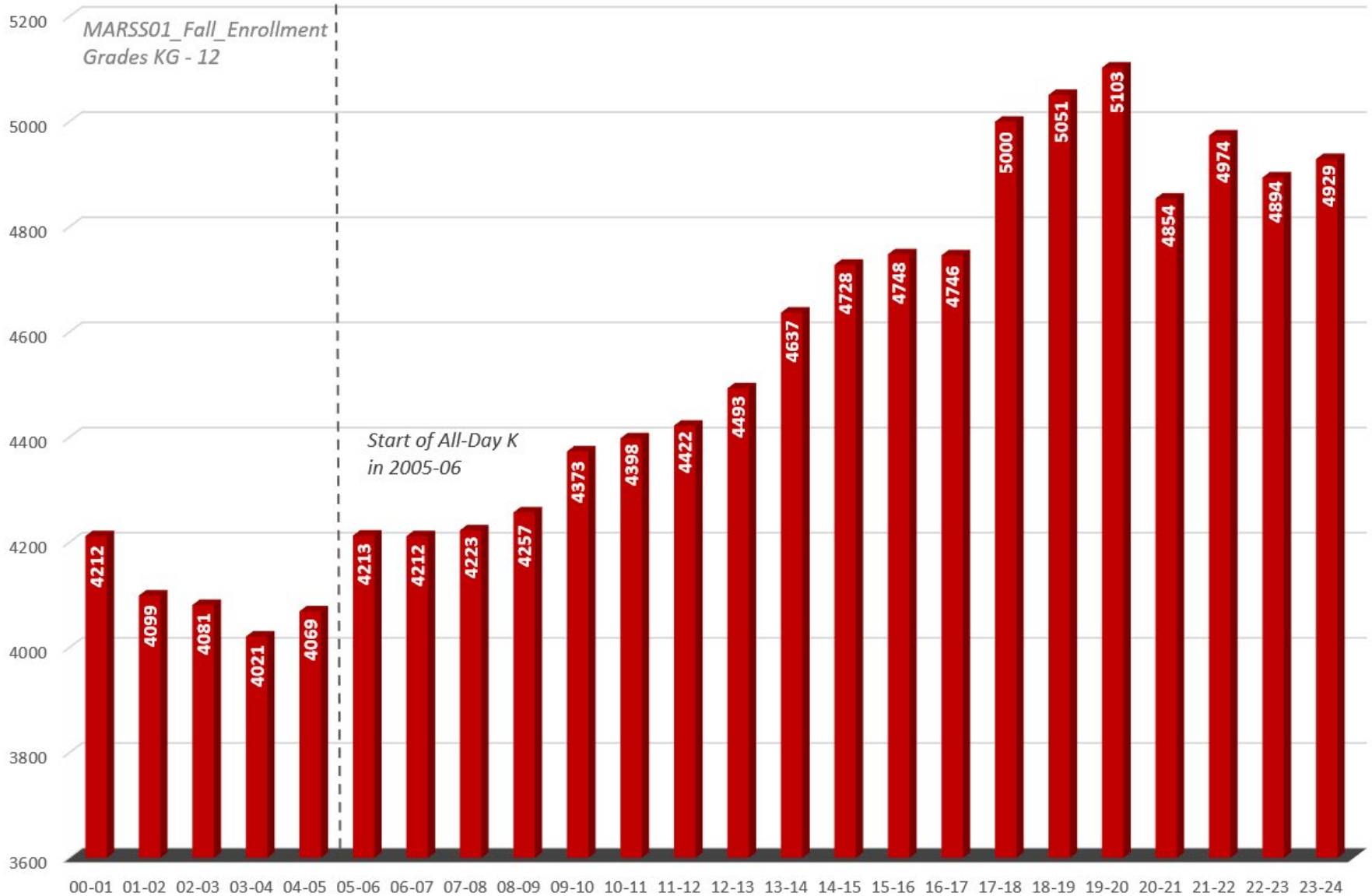
Who we are as a district...

Enrollment Trend

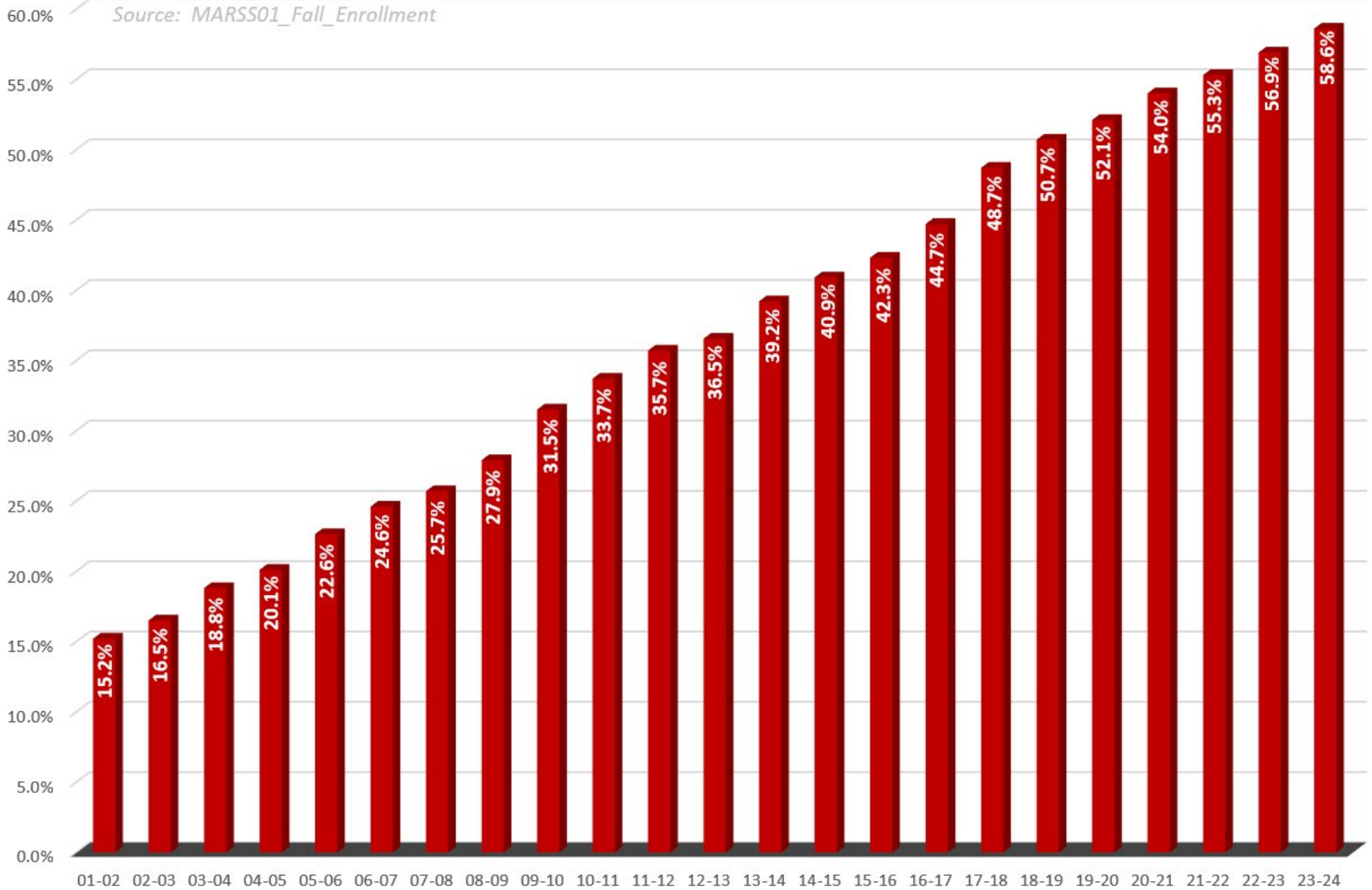

Percent of Non-White Students

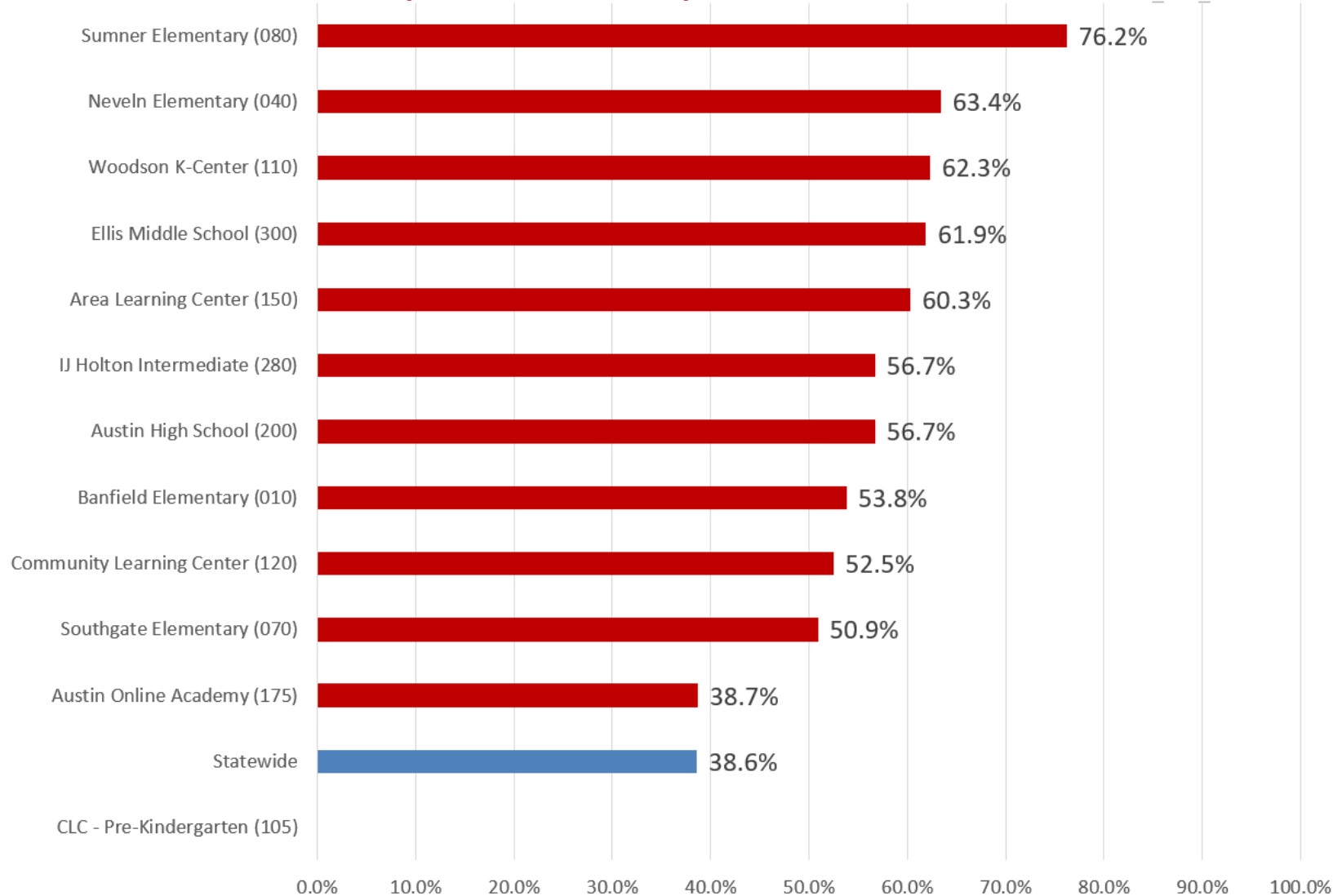

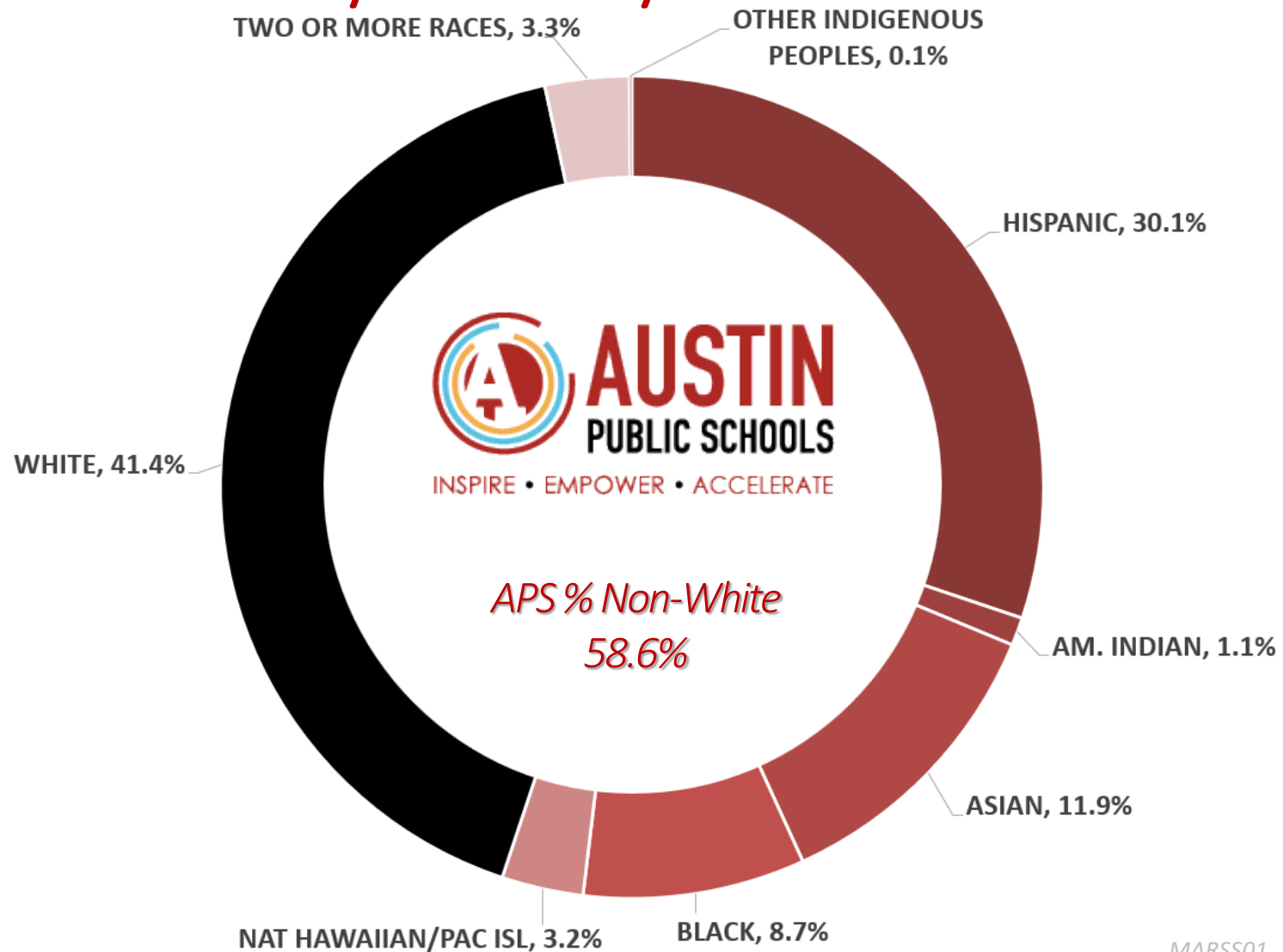

Percent of Non-White Students

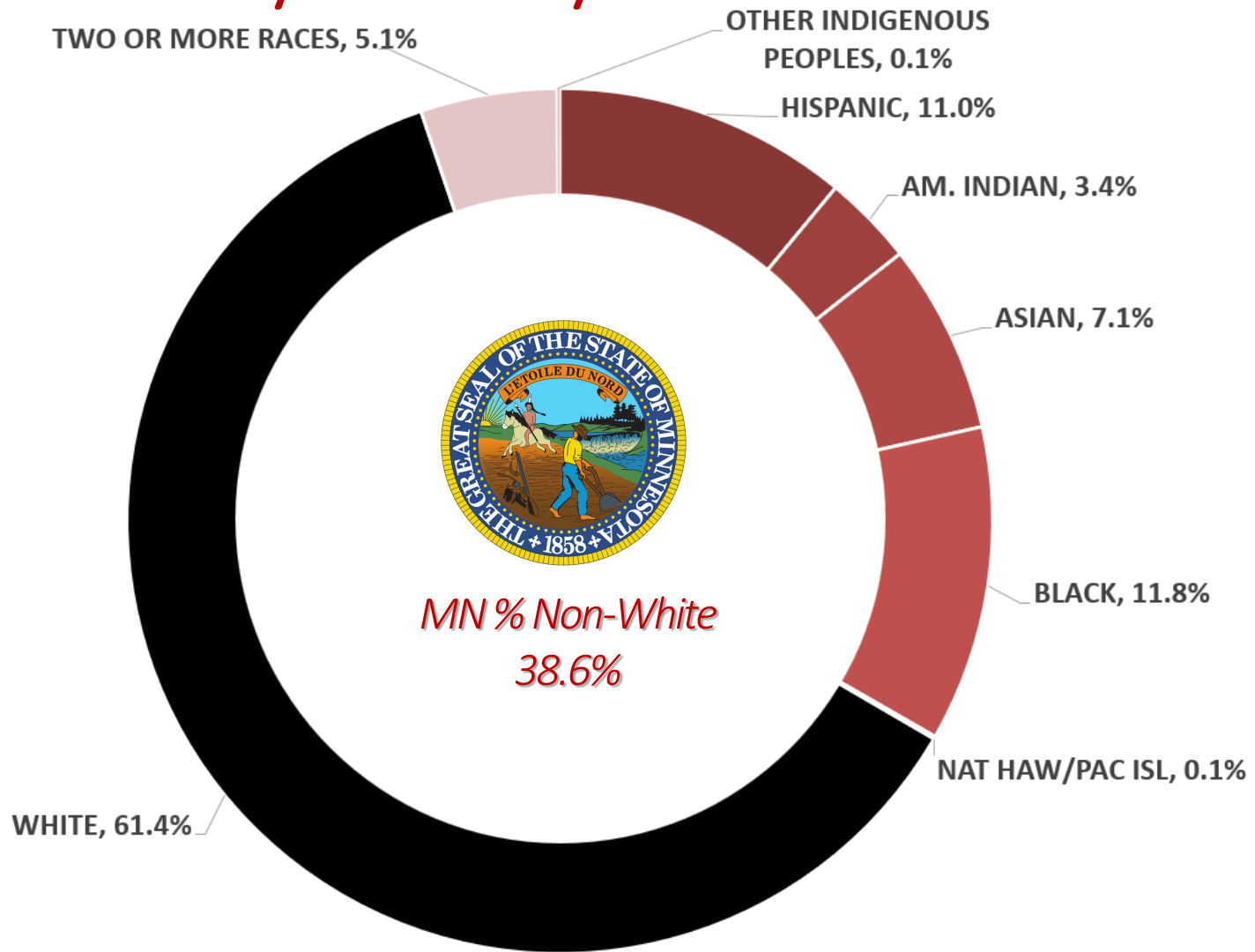

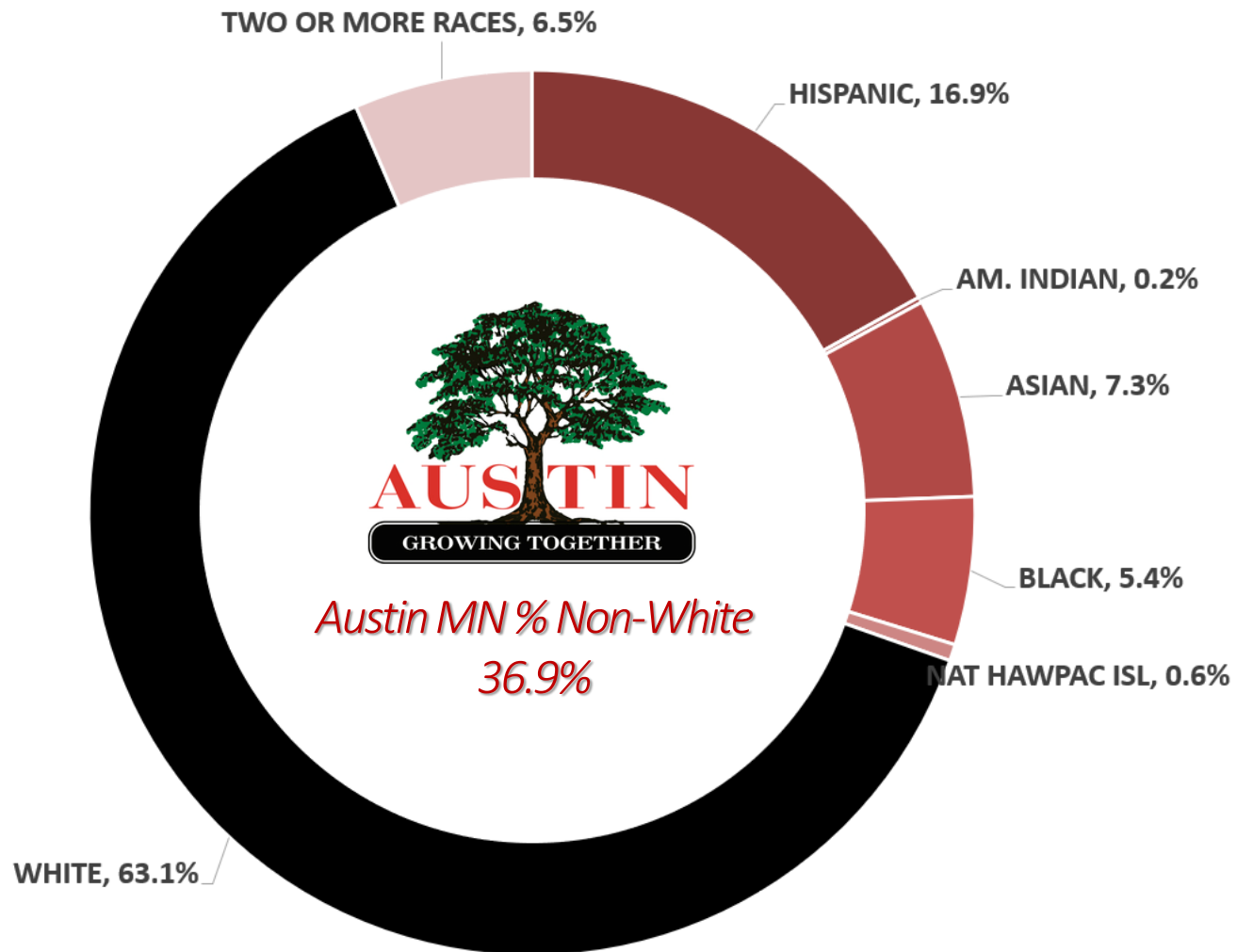

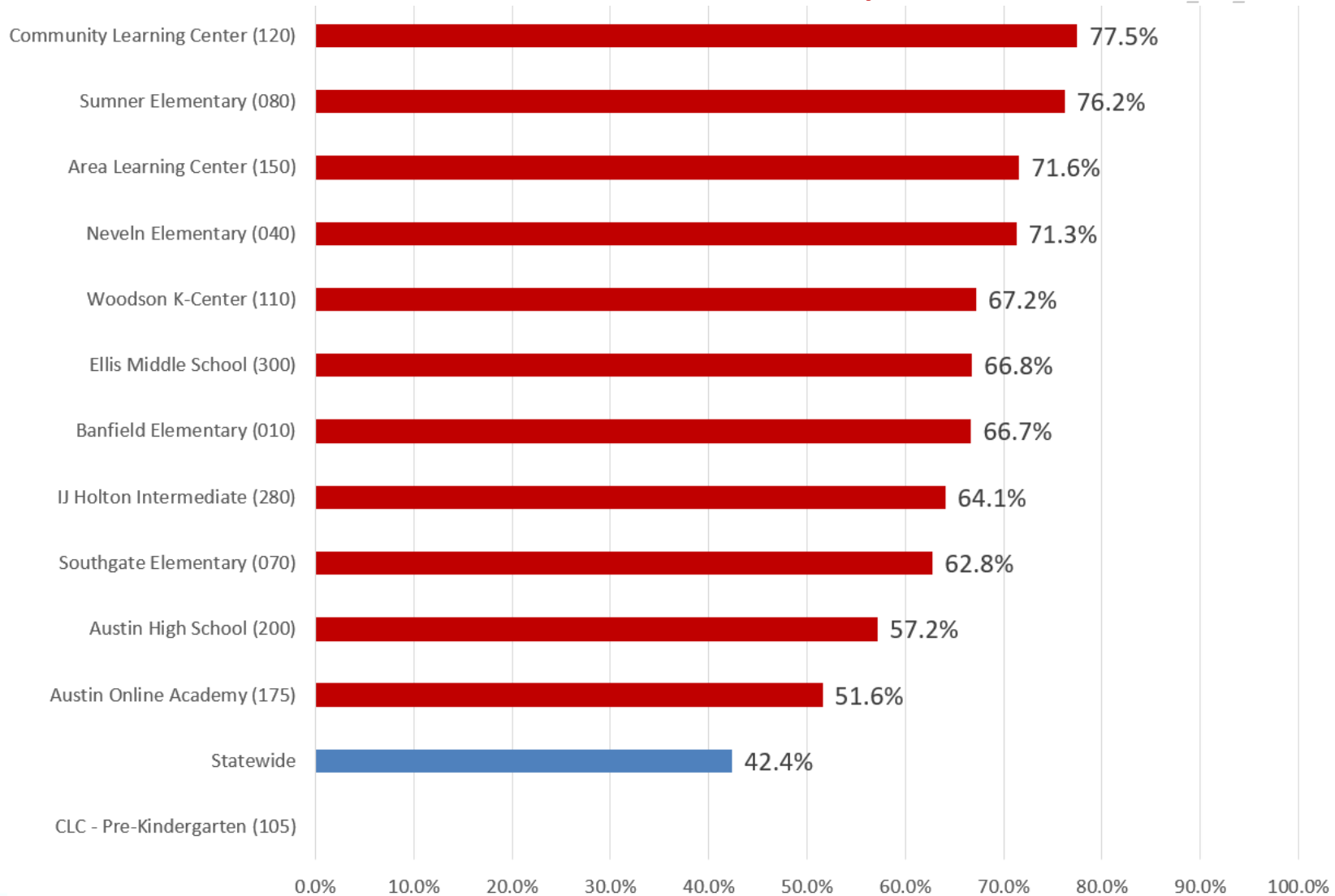

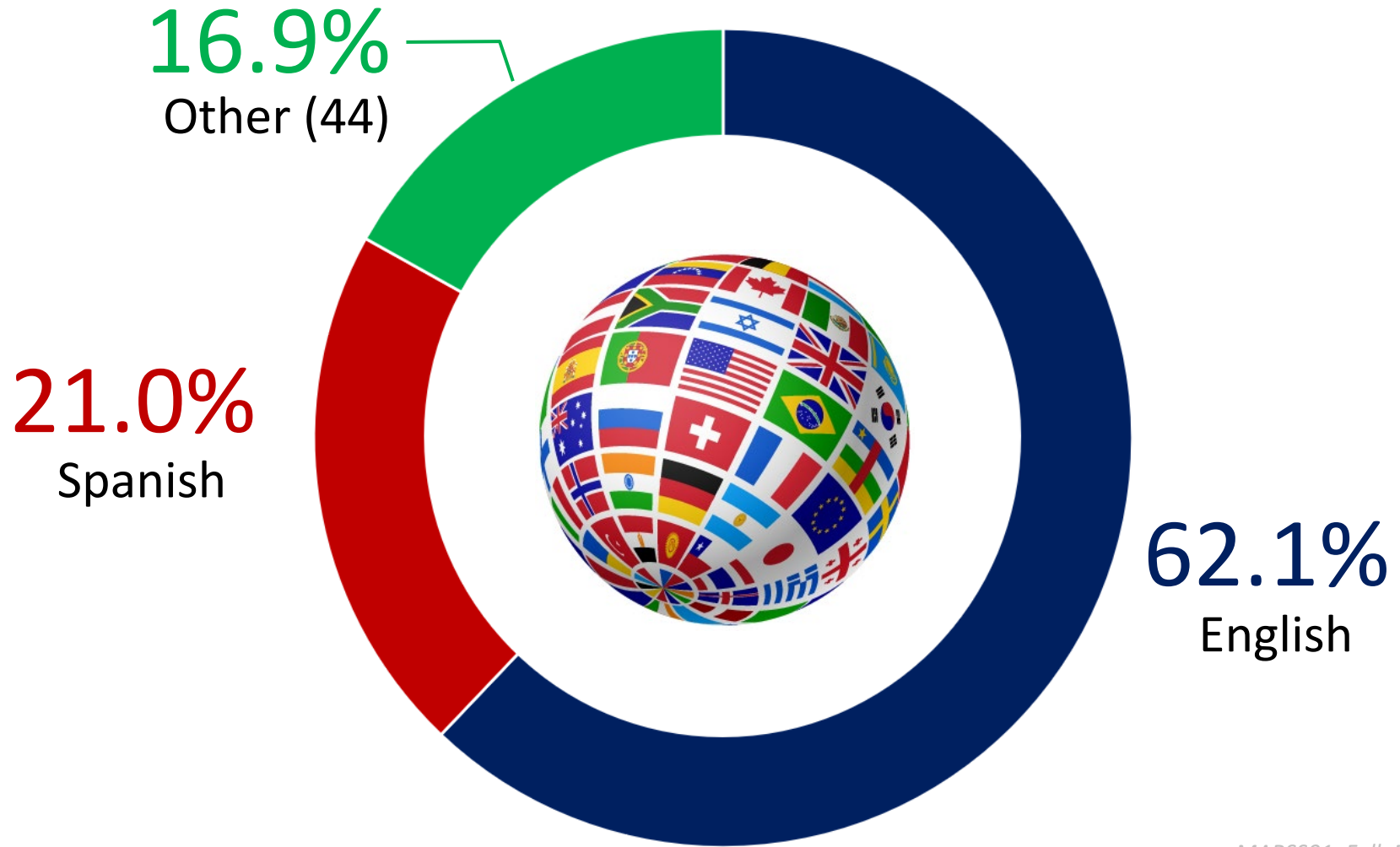

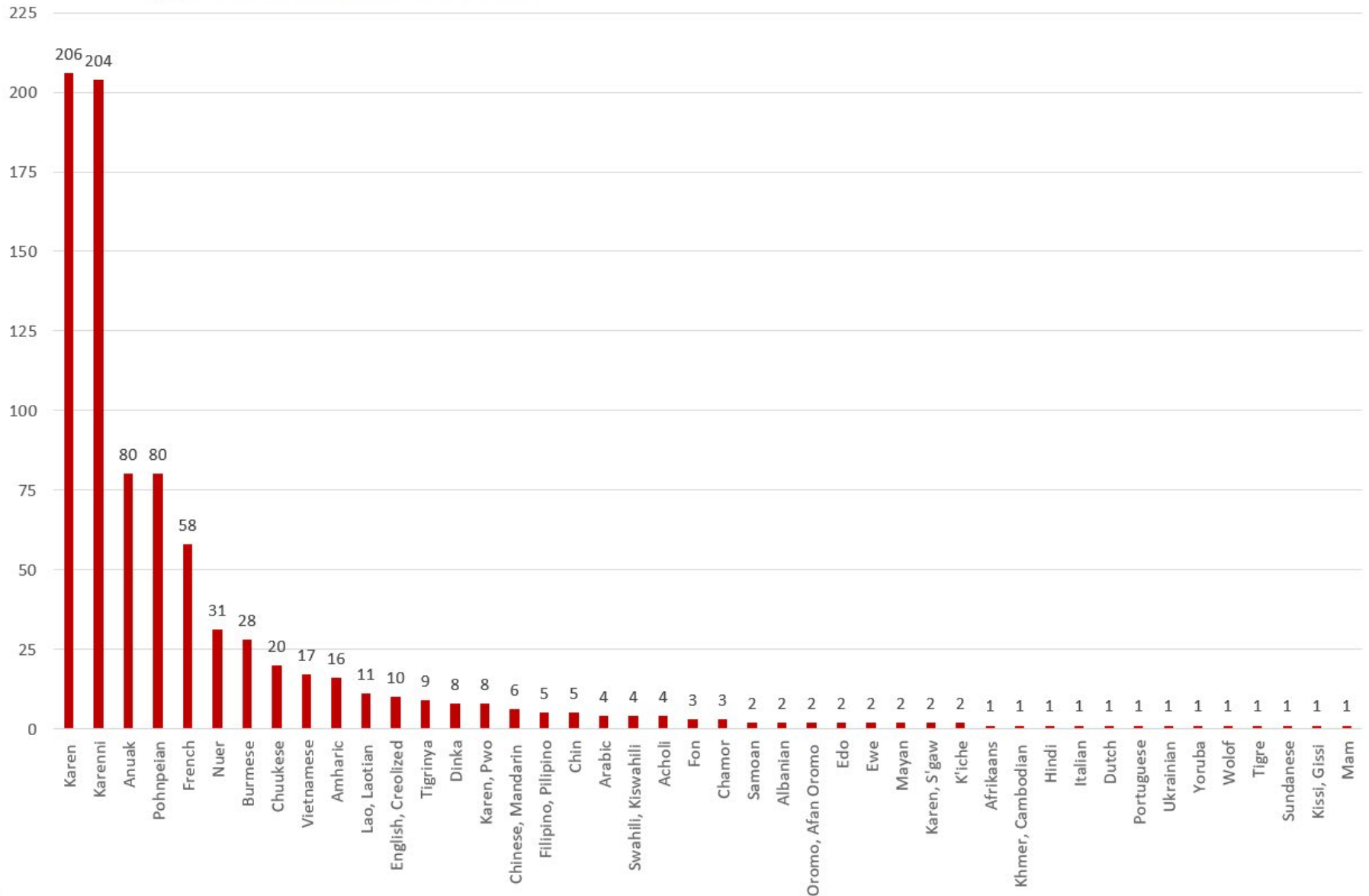
Percent of Students Receiving Free/Reduced Lunch

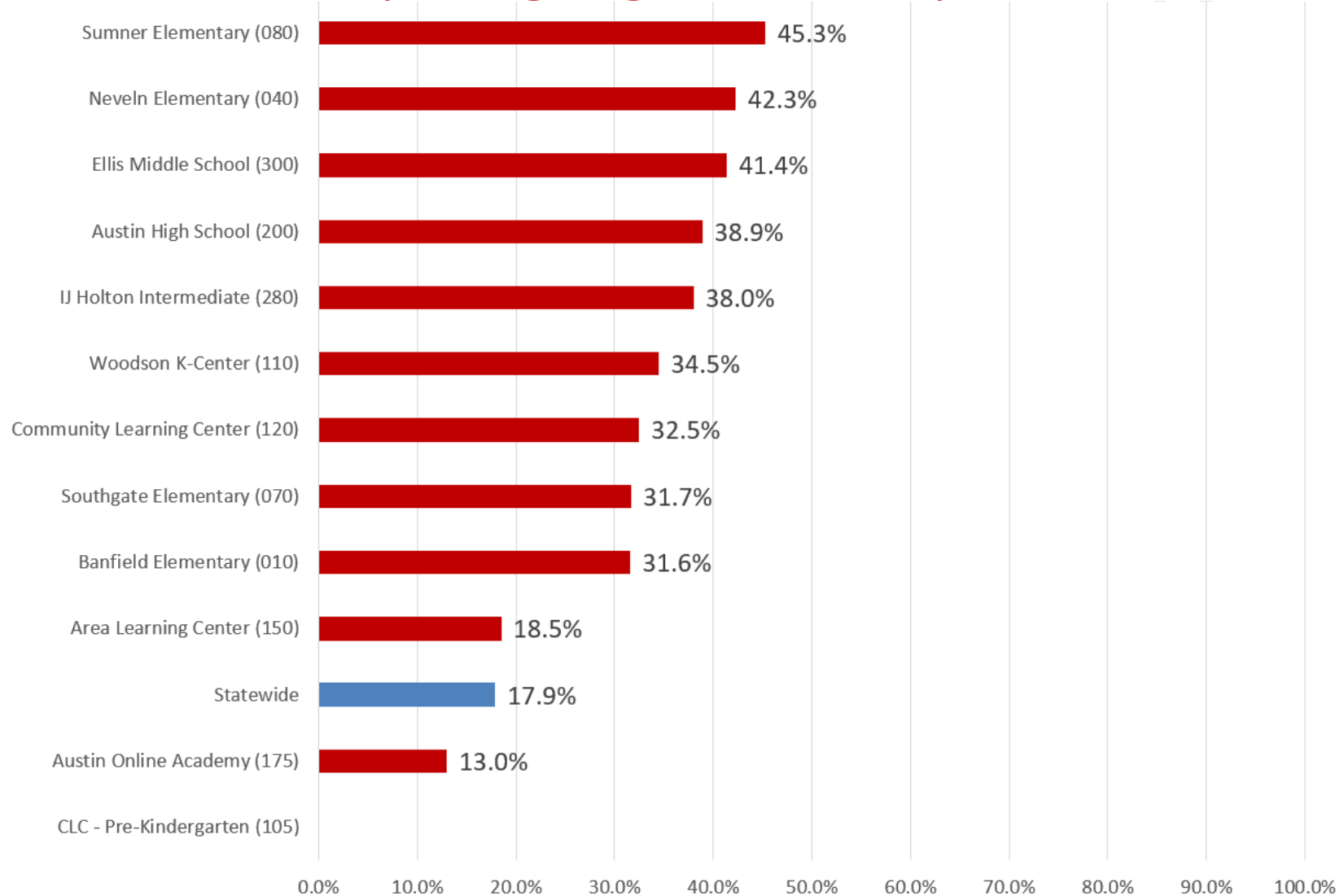

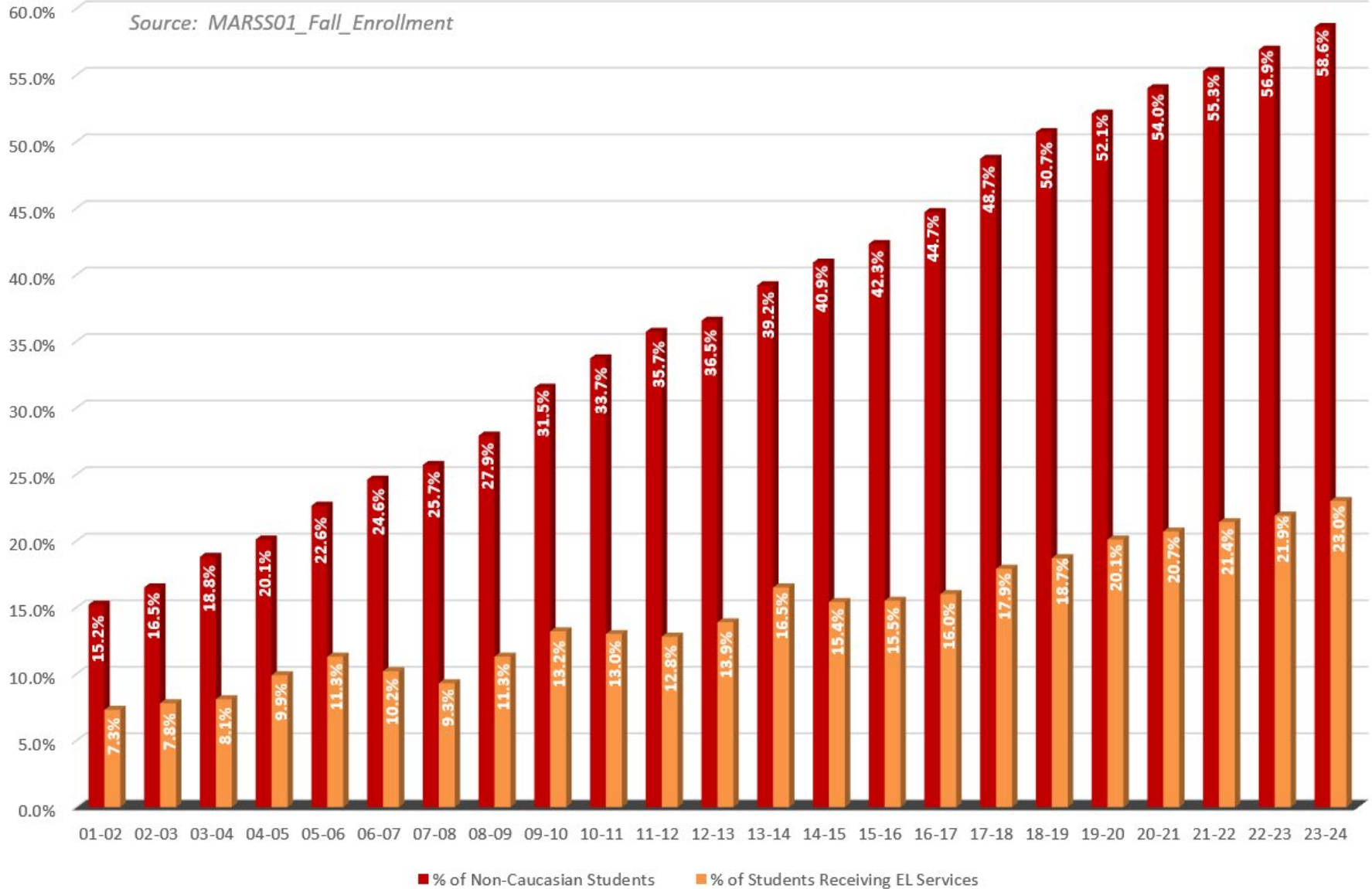

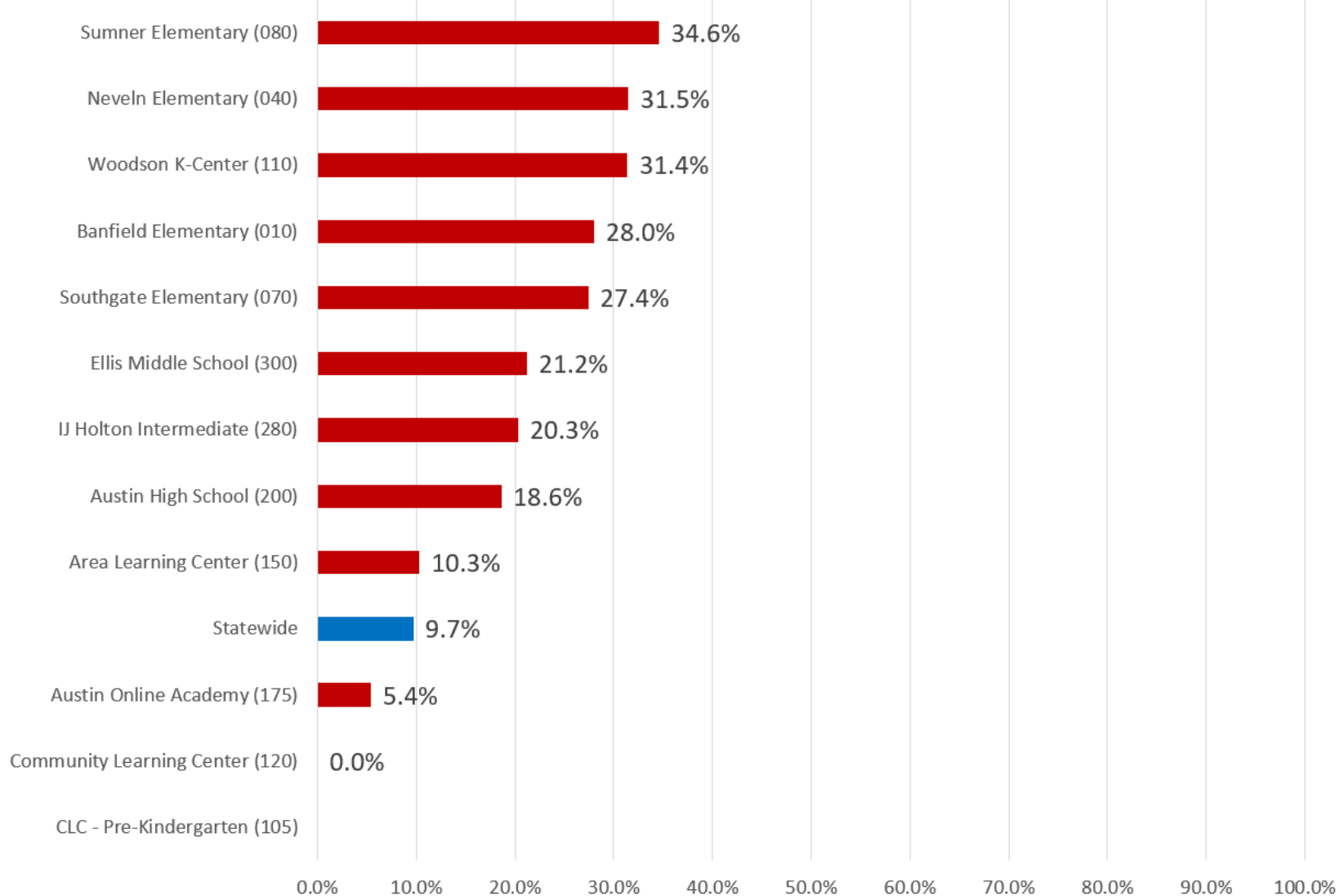
Percent of Students Receiving EL Services
